4. PRESENTATION BY JASON PREISNER, LAMONT ENGINEERING

Discussion around the contract received from Lamont Engineering and what it includes. No permitting is needed at this time; it's all approval based from NYS Department of Health. First step DOH wants us to do is do a pilot study on the carbon filter. Once the sand is replaced at the plant, Jason will work with Water Commissioner Iveson to get that pilot started.

Mayor Gifford suggests we put something in the newsletter first and then send out a letter, drafted by Lamont, to residents. We will hold two informational meetings. One on March  $10^{th}$  at 6:30 pm (prior to Village Board Meeting) and then a second one to be scheduled that evening during the regular board meeting.

NYS EFC has released the Green Energy grant. We will be submitting an application under this for installing the water meters.

#### D. WATER DEPARTMENT:

Water Commissioner Iveson purchased some supplies at Core and Main to have supplies on hand for water main breaks. He called Carver first for the break and they weren't able to get a crew together. He also called Larnard and they weren't able to get equipment but offered a crew.

Joe Coppolo is supposed to come tomorrow with the used circuit board to see if they can get the turbidity meter working. If he cannot fix it, Water Commissioner Iveson will have to make an emergency purchase to purchase a new one. Additionally, the chlorine meter has died.

There is definitely a leak somewhere again. The numbers are up to about 50k per day when they were around 30k per day. Water Commissioner Iveson is not sure if it's perhaps one of the houses that had frozen pipes during the frigid temperatures.

Water Commissioner Iveson would like to remove some sand from the filter beds to help alleviate some issues until he can get the sand replaced in the spring. NYSDOH wants a letter from Lamont Engineering signing off on the plan.

Water Commissioner Iveson will reach out to Dominic at NYSDOH regarding where the water seepage is coming from up on 395 where the culvert project is.
